Principal's Message

A word from Mrs. Bryant

This year has been a year of study and research as the Rogers Adventist School Board and the Walla Walla Valley Academy School Board evaluate whether or not to recommend to the Constituency a K-12 collaboration between Rogers and WWVA.

On Tuesday, February 21, both boards will meet for a final presentation and vote. Depending on the outcome, this recommendation will go to the Constituencies of both schools in April. Please keep this decision in your prayers as we strive to make both Rogers and WWVA stronger.

23-24 Registration

On Wednesday, March 1, **registration opens** for the 23-24 school year. Tuition rates will be going up slightly and those numbers will be published following our school board approval on February 21.

Any current Rogers student who registers during the month of March is guaranteed their seat in the classroom for the 23-24 school year (as long as they are academically and financially eligible). Starting April 1, registration will be open to any new students and if classes fill up before a current student registers, that current student will lose their spot.

Part of the registration process is an enrollment fee. This fee gets more expensive the longer you wait to sign up, so it's in your best interest to jump on registration as soon as it opens March 1!

- Early Registration (March 1-31)
- Regular Registration (April 1-June 2)
- Summer Registration (June 3-beginning of 23-24 school year, or until classes fill up)

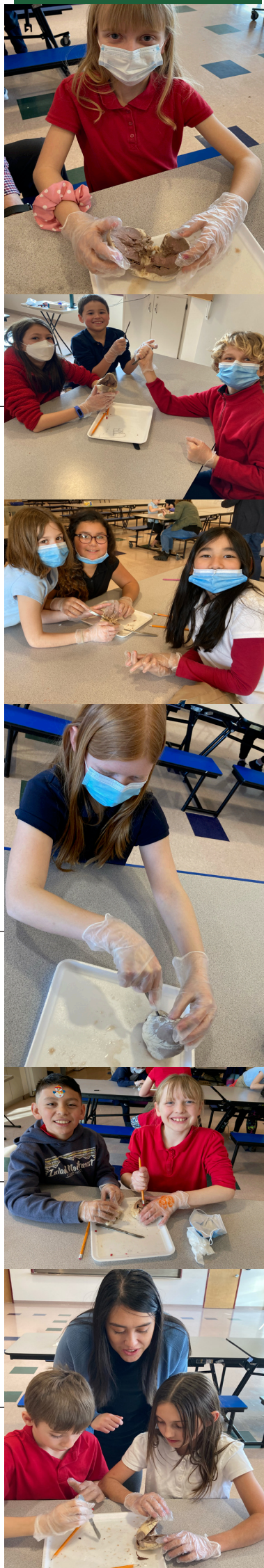
