Garden starts are \$3 each or 4 for \$10.

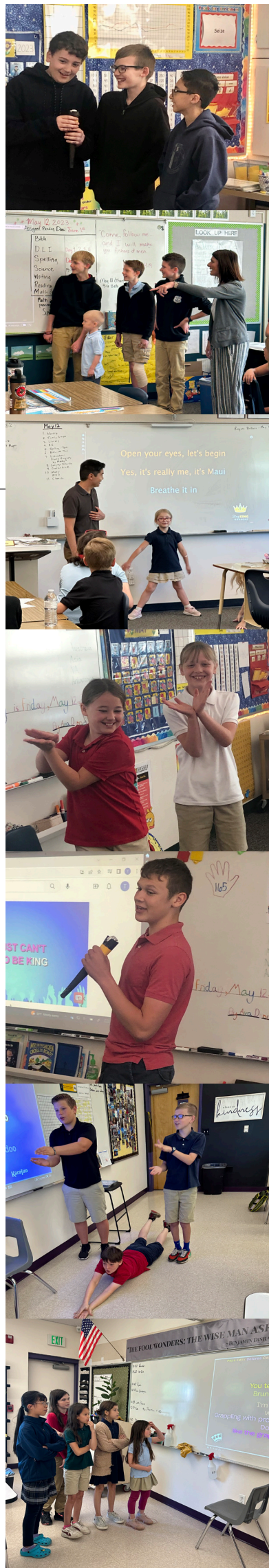
